

CONTRACT FOR SCHOOL SHOW PARTICIPATION: Please read these TEN COMMANDMENTS of the GBDS School Show.

1. Communication about the show, rehearsals, costumes, tickets, etc. is ALL done by email to save paper, so PLEASE read all of the emails that you receive with regard to the show.
2. While we do try to limit the amount of emails, there is a great deal of information that we need to get to both students and parents, so please bear with us if you are receiving a lot of emails... but do read them all!
3. We work very hard to make the schedule as accommodating as possible to parents. However, it is up to you to arrange your own carpools and transportation after rehearsals. Please do NOT email, call, or text us during rehearsals to ask for help with carpooling. We will send out a list of all of the participants in the show, so that you can arrange carpools ahead of time. Please do not wait until the last minute to arrange transport.
4. All students must be picked up from rehearsal on time. If your child is required to come to a rehearsal which is not immediately after school at 3:30pm, then you do not need to pay for aftercare. If your child(ren) will be staying for aftercare AFTER his/her rehearsal has ended, then you will be charged for aftercare. Students who are in aftercare are required to do homework.
5. We take the school show, and all that it entails, very seriously and we expect the same of the students. If a student is disrespectful or uncooperative during rehearsals, he or she will be asked to leave and will not take part in the show. Of course, we do not expect this to happen, but there will be no second chances. Please make sure that your child understands this.
6. While we understand that illness and emergencies do happen, students are required to attend all rehearsals for their particular part. A rehearsal schedule will be sent out a few weeks in advance; due to many circumstances, however, it is always subject to change. Please be prepared to be flexible.
7. Participation in the school show and attendance at rehearsals does not exempt your child from any homework assignments that are given by the teachers. It is the students' responsibility to make sure that all homework is completed, and the show cannot be used as an "excuse!"
8. At the end of each rehearsal, we producers need to meet, clean up and re-organize the room(s) we have been using. We also want to go home! Please PICK UP YOUR CHILDREN ON TIME!
9. We work very hard to ensure that every child in Kdg. – 8th grade who wants to be in the show gets a part. We match the part to the actor and take into consideration the acting, singing, dancing and memorizing capabilities of our students. Please be assured that we do our very best for each student.
10. This is going to be our THIRTEENTH GBDS school show... please help us to make it the best yet!
